



2009 BLOCK RECOVERY GRANT APPLICATION

A program to help blocks recover from the July storm affecting western Wheat Ridge.

Purpose: The July 20th storm caused significant damage in parts of Wheat Ridge. Property owners have worked with their insurance companies and neighbors to start the recovery. Wheat Ridge 2020 is encouraged by the community spirit when neighbors come together to make a difference and wants to support those efforts for helping the community recover and move forward after this storm. WR2020 will help with matching funds or small grants up to \$300 for projects aiding in block recovery. Potential projects could be a dumpster for block cleanup, supplies for a block party to celebrate the hard work done in clean up, flowers and plants to add color or trees to aid in revegetating the area. Submit what your block needs.

Eligibility: All Wheat Ridge neighborhoods impacted by the severe weather this summer are eligible. Neighbors must submit projects that are beneficial to the whole block or neighborhood (please define an area that makes sense for your neighbors) for recovery and have neighbors sign the application showing they plan to participate. Those leveraging resources (donations or volunteer labor or inkind supplies) will have priority.

Details: Selected applicants will be informed in writing. Applicants should keep receipts from projects and submit for reimbursement of up to \$300 when project is complete.

As a part of receiving this grant, Wheat Ridge 2020 representatives will come to drop off a WR2020 sign to display, distribute WR2020 info and answer questions. WR2020 representatives may also stop by to say hello during your project and to talk with your neighbors about the activities of our organization.

Reporting: Finally, as part of our accountability to the community, we ask that the event organizer submit a final report evaluating the success of the project. Also, please take pictures of the project to submit to WR2020. A sample of the Final Report is available.

Our sincerest thanks to all the neighbors who have come together and shared tools and worked together to help our community recover from the damage caused by severe weather. Your efforts and actions are inspiring.

We know that \$300 will not be able to cover the significant damage in any area, but we hope assistance is received knowing that Wheat Ridge 2020 desires to be a part of encouraging and supporting community spirit and neighbor cooperation in the clean up effort.
